



EELS ON A STRING

- What you need: string
one lolly python for each child
clothes line or someone to hang the python on the string from
(the python has to be hanging just slightly higher than the head height of each child)
- Music requirements: None
- Age suitability: 2+

Cut pieces of string at different lengths ranging from approximately 1 metre to 3 metres. The quantity of the number of string lengths depends on the number of children around each age. The younger the child the longer the piece of string required.

Tie the string around the python at one end being sure not to pull the string too tight so that it cuts through the python.

Tie the other end of the string over the clothes line or the beam that you want them to hang from. Be sure to make the python hang at a reachable height by the different aged children when they are standing on their toes with their head up and not using their hands.

Hot tip: Be sure your pets are locked up so as to not participate in eating all the pythons before the game starts.

You can lower the clothesline when ready to play this game. It also makes an effective decoration until the children are ready to play. You can tie strips of crepe paper or something similar to create any effect you desire.
