



# MASK PARADE

- What you need: each child needs one paper plate with eyeholes cut out, a piece of elastic attached around the back for each child, colouring pens and a selection of stick-on items like plastic jewels, glitter, feathers, sequins, wool, string, stamps, stickers
- Music requirements: None
- Age suitability: 3+

Before the party starts cut eye holes in each paper plate. You also need to put two small holes (one on each side of the plate) and tie one end of the elastic to one side. You need to tie the second side once you measure the size of the child's head.

Sit the children around a table or on the floor with sheets of newspaper or the like and give each child a mask to decorate however they want. When they have finished they can have a parade around the room.

If you have a specific theme like animals you can ask all the children to make animal faces. Small children love this game, particular little girls.

We recommend to use glue sticks or clag in a pot rather than really runny glue which will probably end up everywhere.
